COUNTY MAYOR – FINANCIAL UPDATE, BOARD APPOINTMENTS, BUDGET AMENDMENTS

Mayor Jimmy Sain presented four (4) budget amendments; (1) Hardeman County Clerk debit from Deputies Salaries (52500-106) and credit to Part-time Personnel (52500-169) in the amount of \$5,259.36 for full-time deputy taking 16 weeks maternity leave, hiring part-time deputy; (2) Ambulance/Emergency Medical Services debit from Fund Balance (39000) and credit to Gasoline (55130-425) in the amount of \$337.61 for the check cut on 5/01/2020 FY 2019-2020 never cleared. It was cancelled and had to be reissued on September 11, 2020 out of FY 2020-2021; (3) Hardeman County Sheriff's Office debit from Other Charges (54220-599) and credit to Office Equipment (54220-719) in the amount of \$2,400.00 for Installment from Konica Minolta – New budget line; (4) Hardeman County Sheriff's Office debit from Fund Balance (39000) and credit to Gasoline (54110-425) in the amount of \$2,654.67 for there were two charges from FY 2019-2020 for Fuelman, \$1,236.57 and \$1,418.10, in which the checks got lost in the mail. Stop payments were on those checks and a new check was issued on 9/11/2020, check #01151165. Hon. Johnny Lanier made a motion and Hon. Chandra Lake seconded to approve said budget amendments.
